Preamble:

Public utilities, whether centralized or decentralized need to manage public money on a daily basis in order to meet the general needs of the community .

The concept of public money is different from the private in many ways in terms of control and methods of collection .

Public money in both Islamic law and Algerian law arises in several ways, the most important of which are: acquisition, devolution of property that does not belong to the state, seizure, nationalization, and expropriation for public benefit and preemption. It has several characteristics, including: it is not permissible to be disposed of, and it is not permissible to possess the statute of limitations, and may not be seized.

The Islamic Sharia and Algerian law provided for several mechanisms to control public money, most notably: administrative control, political control, control of private bodies, in addition to the control of public opinion in its various components, associations, unions, media, etc. Despite the interest of the Algerian legal system in controlling public finances, it still faces challenges that have led to its waste and lack of rationalization of its spending.

Based on the above, the following problem can be raised:

How effective is the protection of public money and its control mechanisms in Algerian law? How can Islamic law benefit from this in order to maintain it and rationalize its spending?

Themes of the Forum:

The first axis: what is public money in Islamic law and Algerian law (concept, characteristics, methods of training, criteria for distinguishing between public money and private money ..).

Axis II: Control of public funds and mechanisms in Islamic law and Algerian law.

The third axis: the civil protection of public money in Islamic law and Algerian law.

Axis IV: Criminal protection of public money in Islamic law and Algerian law?

The fifth axis: the reality and prospects of protecting public money in the Algerian legal system.
